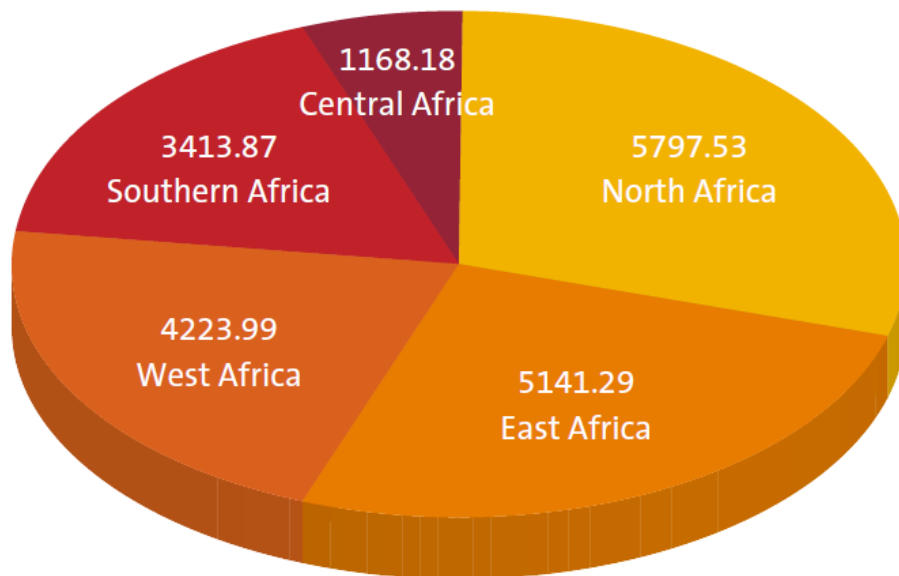
Approach

- Statistical analysis of development cooperation based on OECD-DAC database on official development aid (ODA)
- Focus of mapping exercise on major, multi-country initiatives and programs
 - 58 major initiatives
- Multi-phase approach with regular input from stakeholders
 - Selection of initiatives
 - Data collection
 - Validation of data
 - Data analysis and development of resulting policy messages

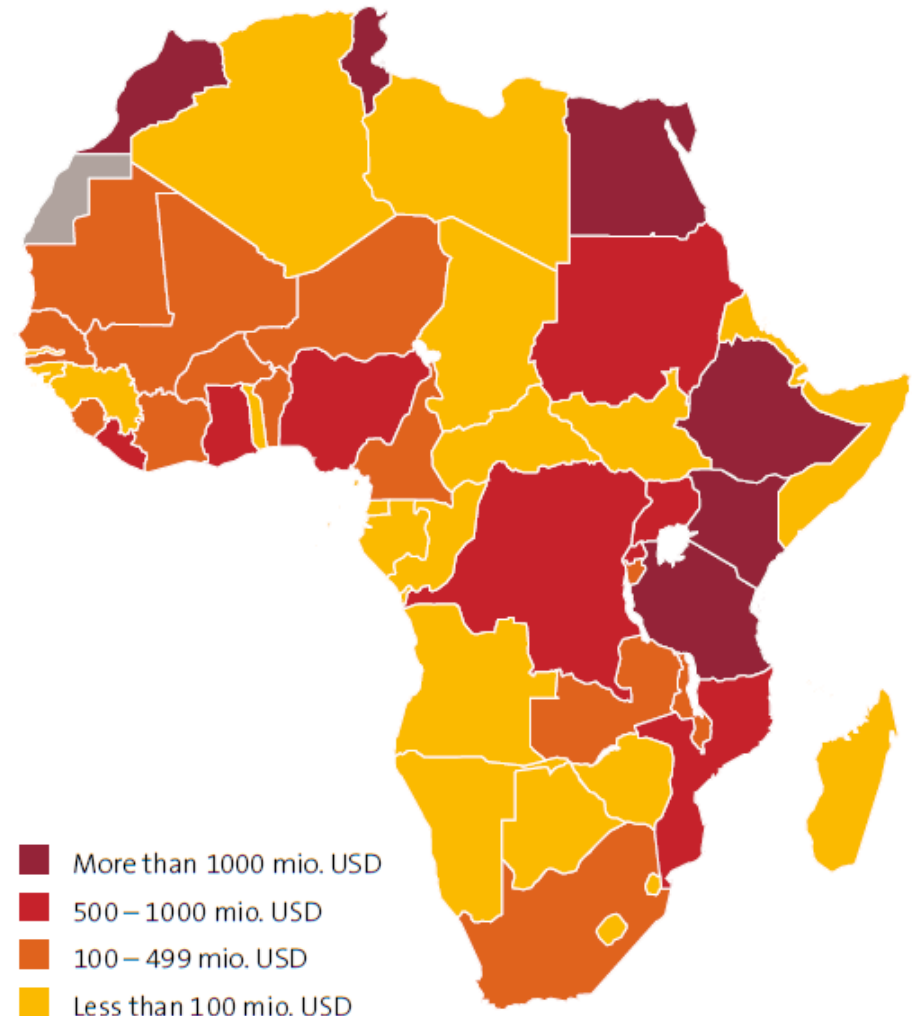


Geographic distribution of ODA

- Focus on several North and East African countries
- Central Africa receives least energy ODA

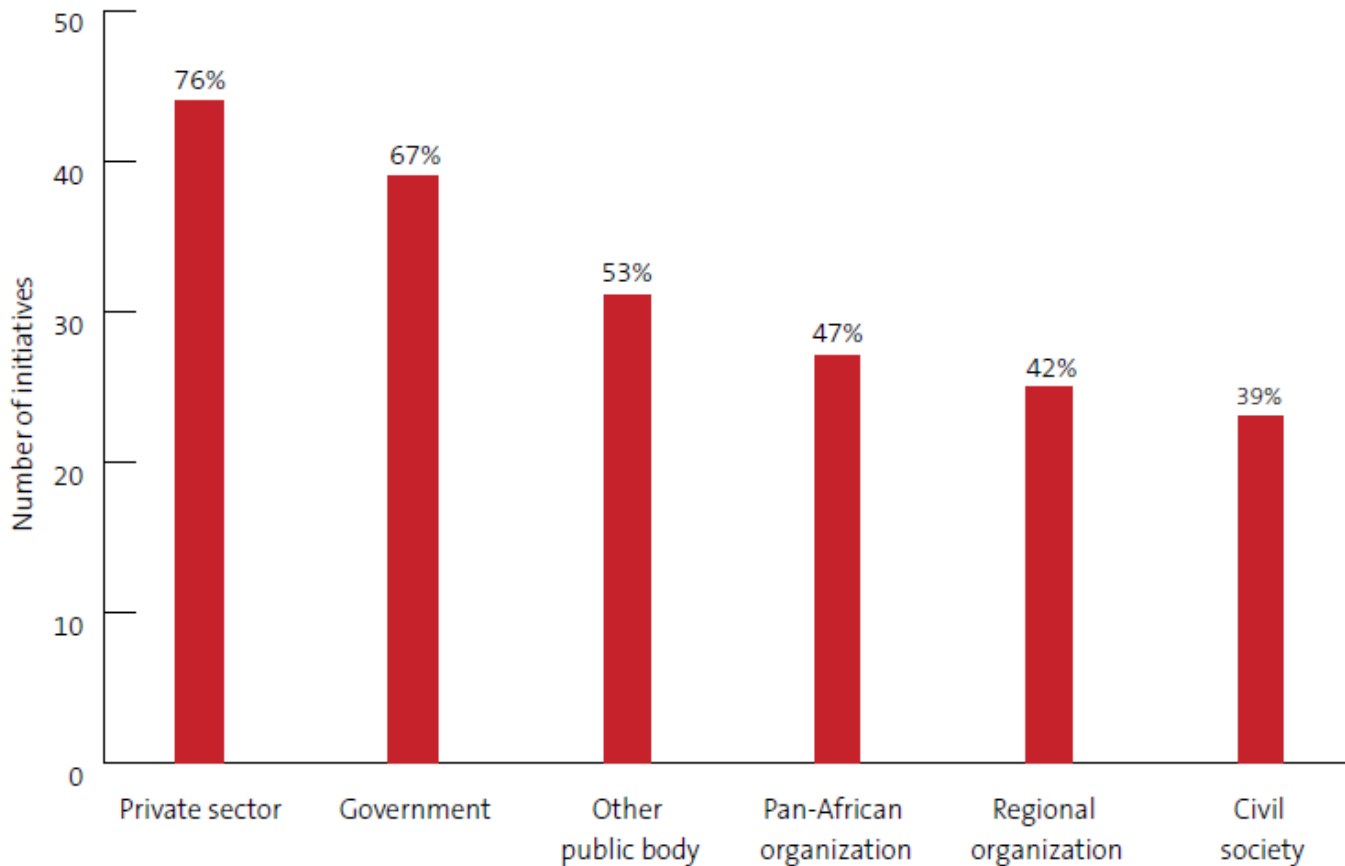


ODA flows to the energy sector in Africa by region, 2009–2013 (in million USD)



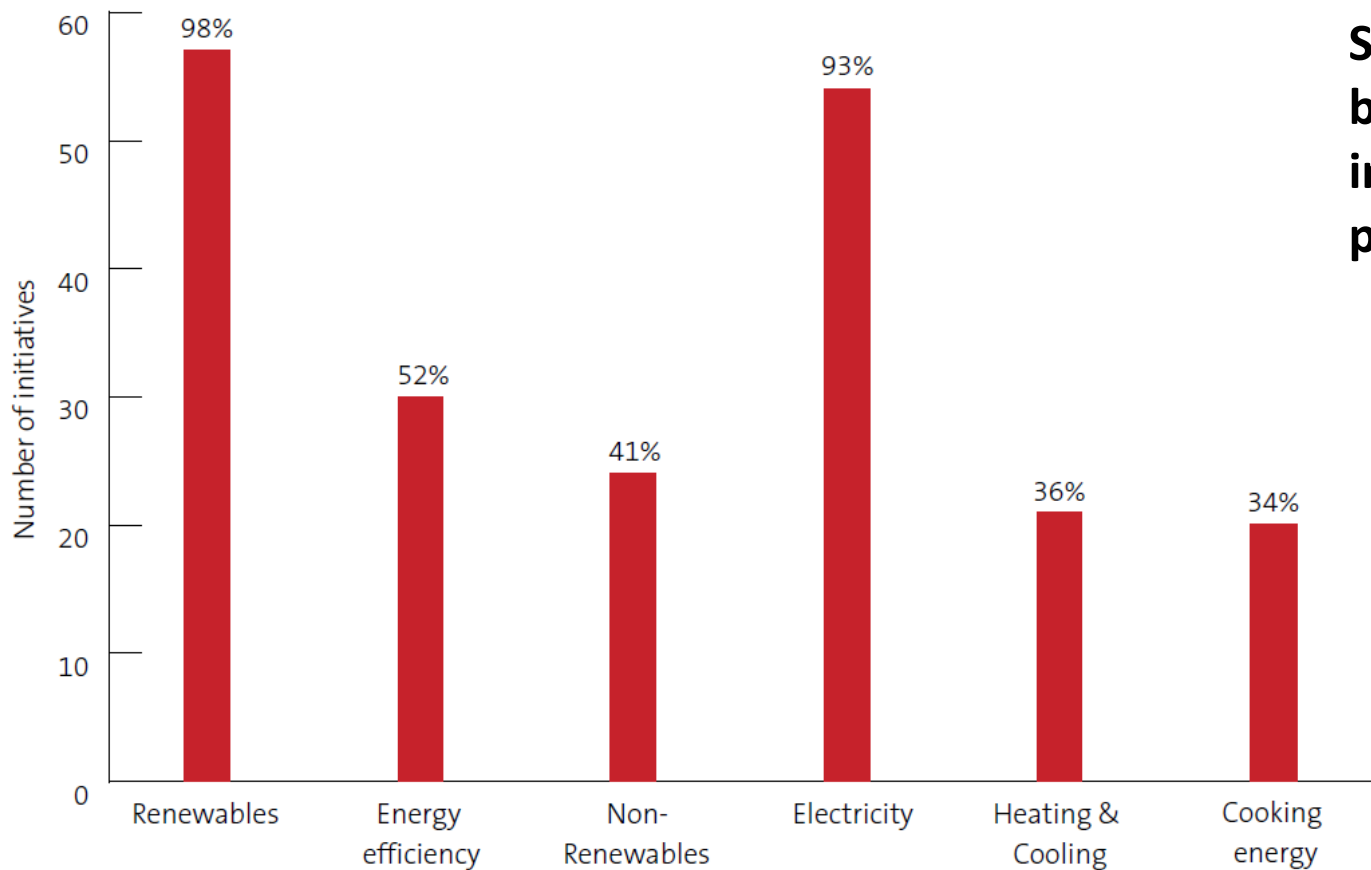


High level of private sector involvement versus relatively low level of civil society participation



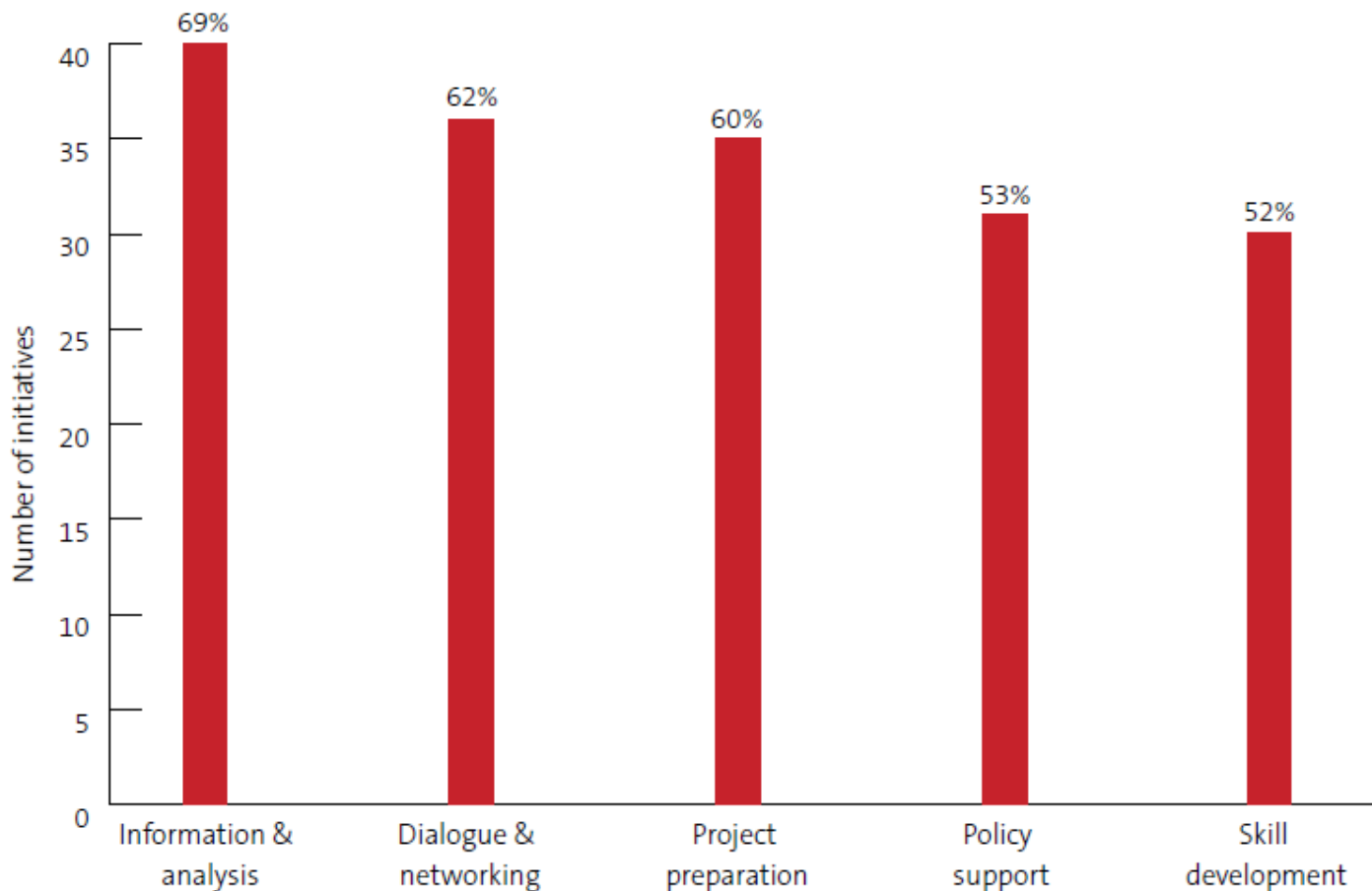
African partners involved in selected initiatives and programs
