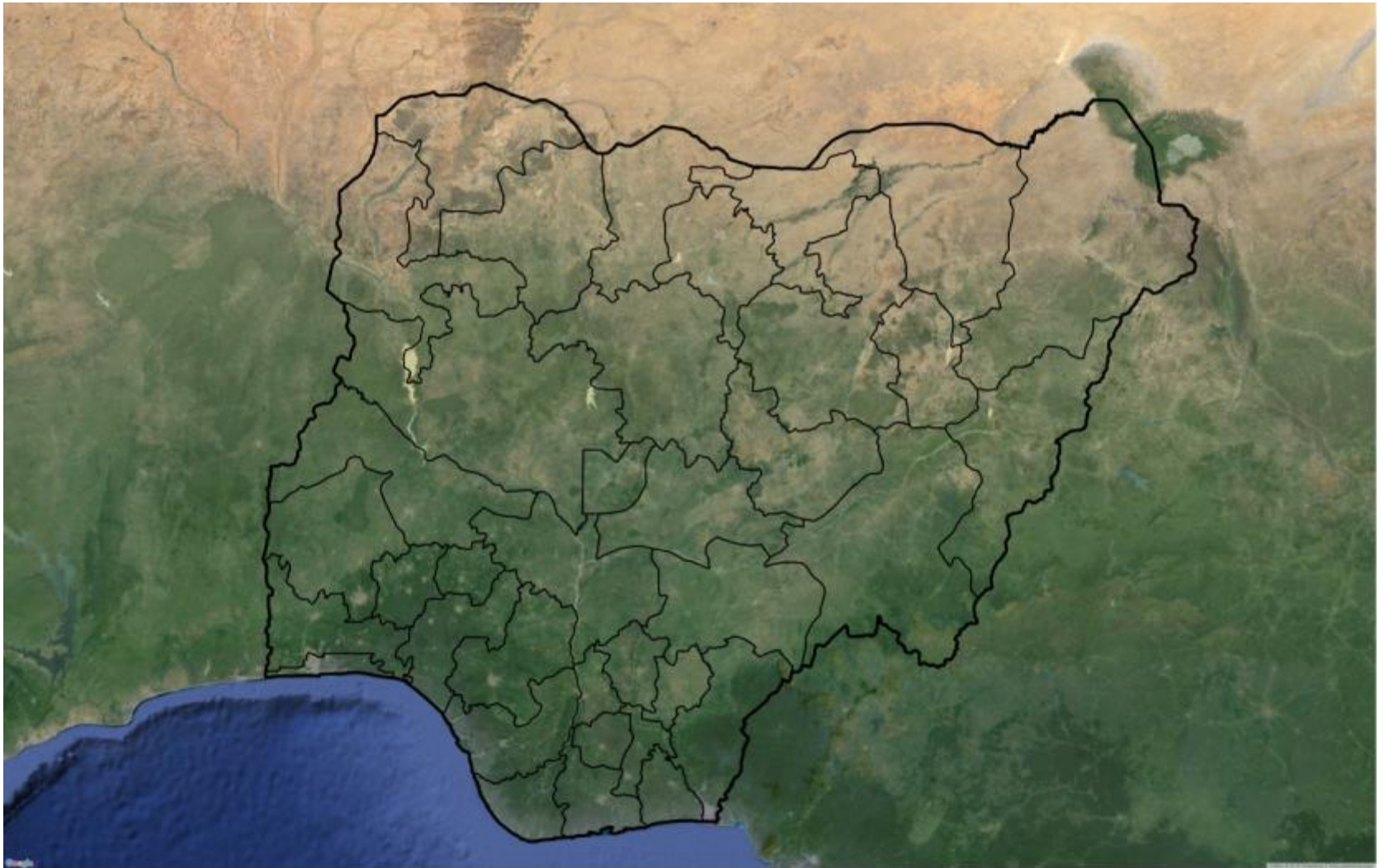

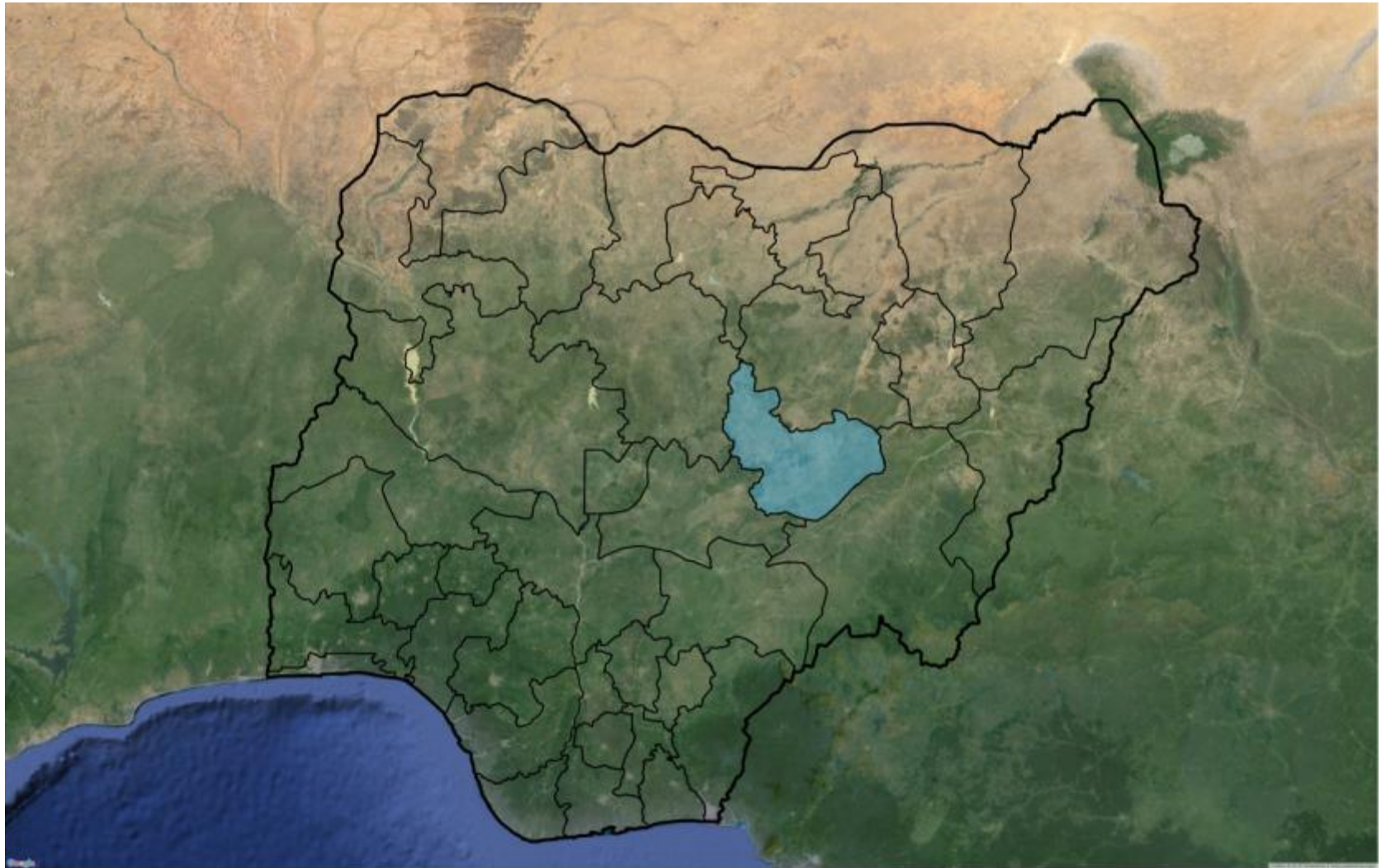

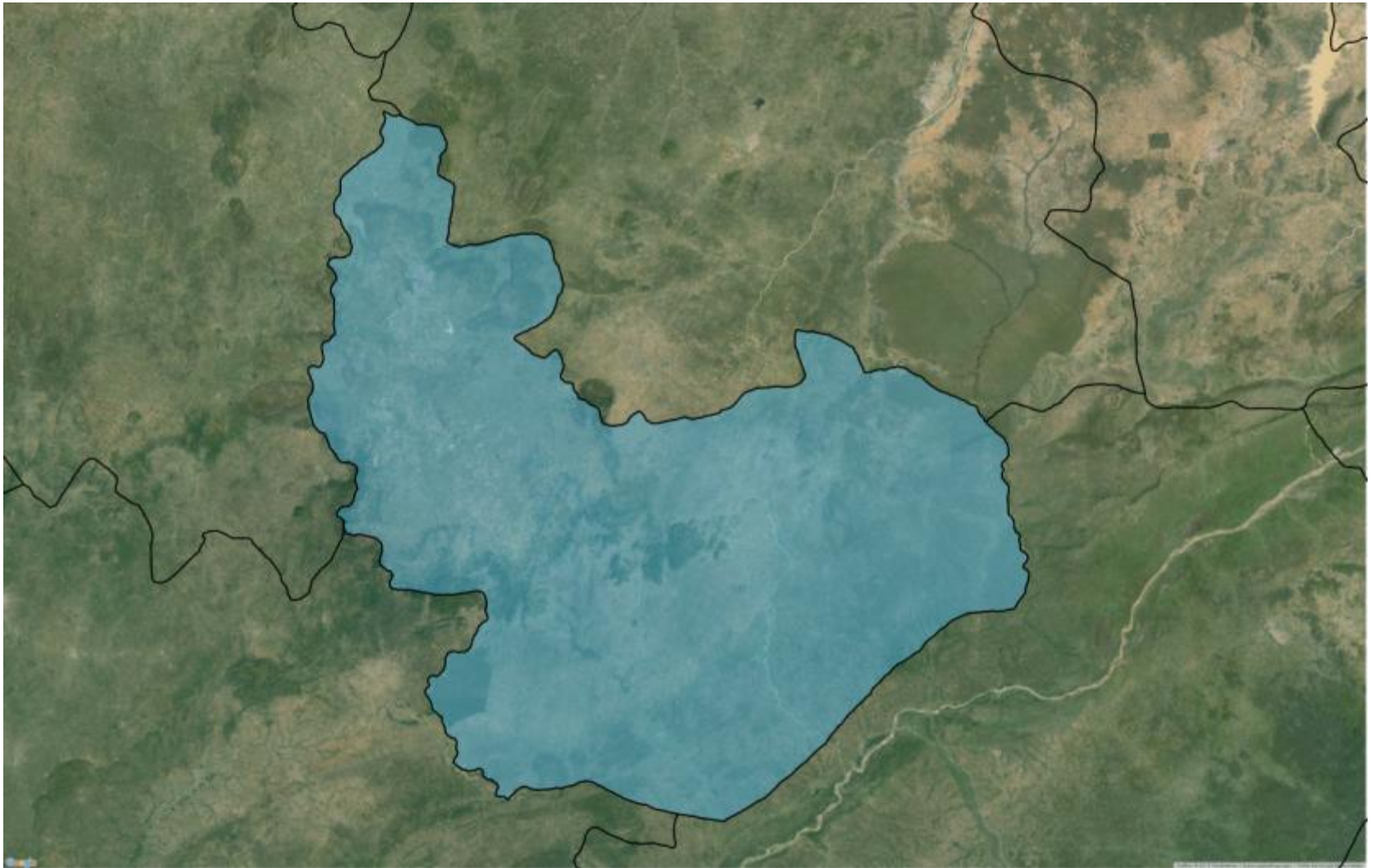
Nigeria: Still 46 % live without access to electricity



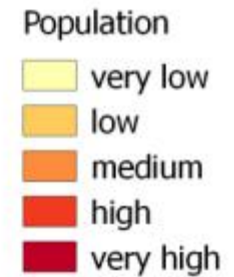
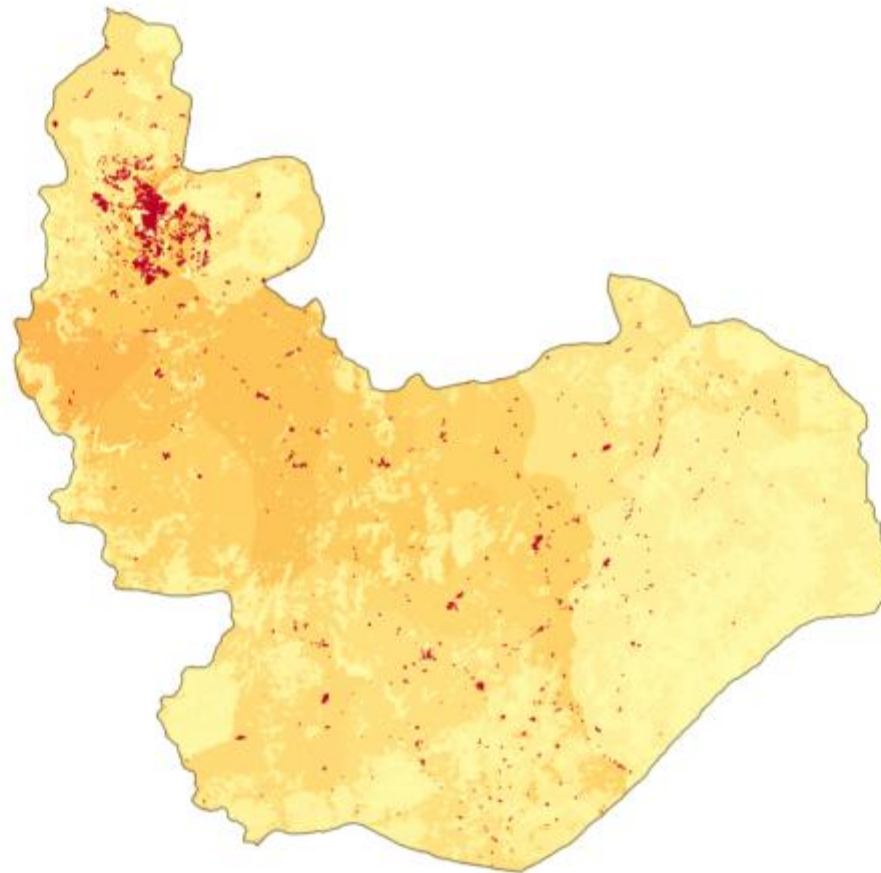
Map of Nigeria – Plateau zoom



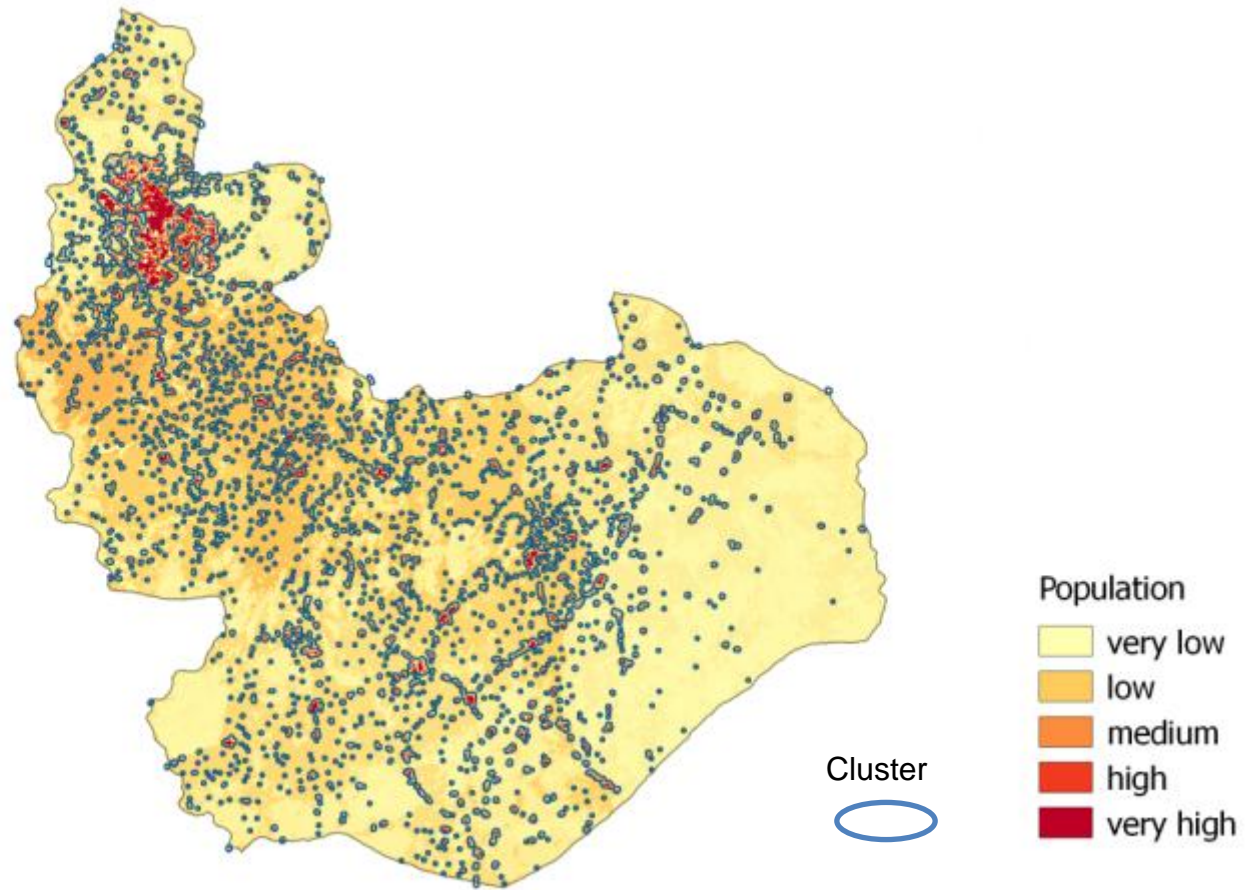
Map of Nigeria – Plateau zoom



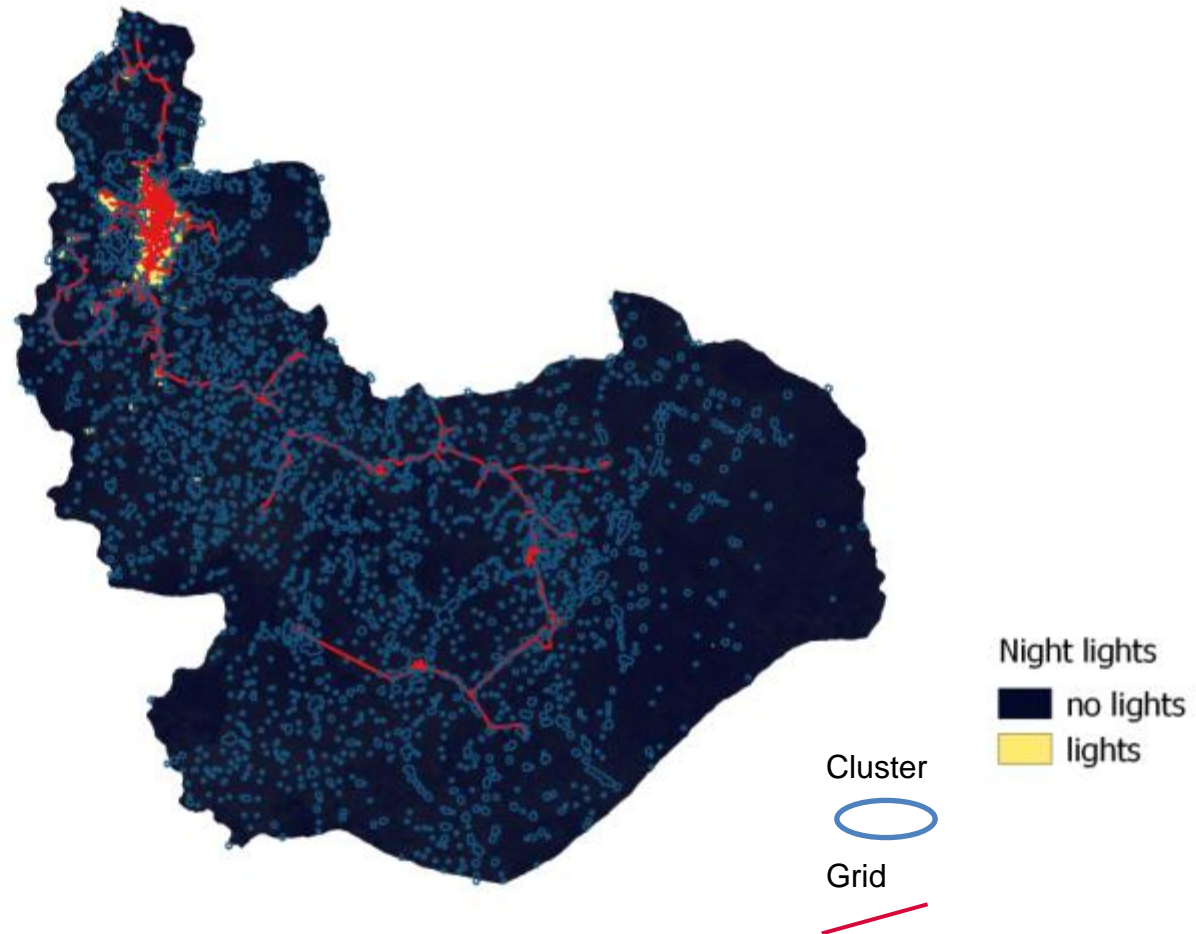

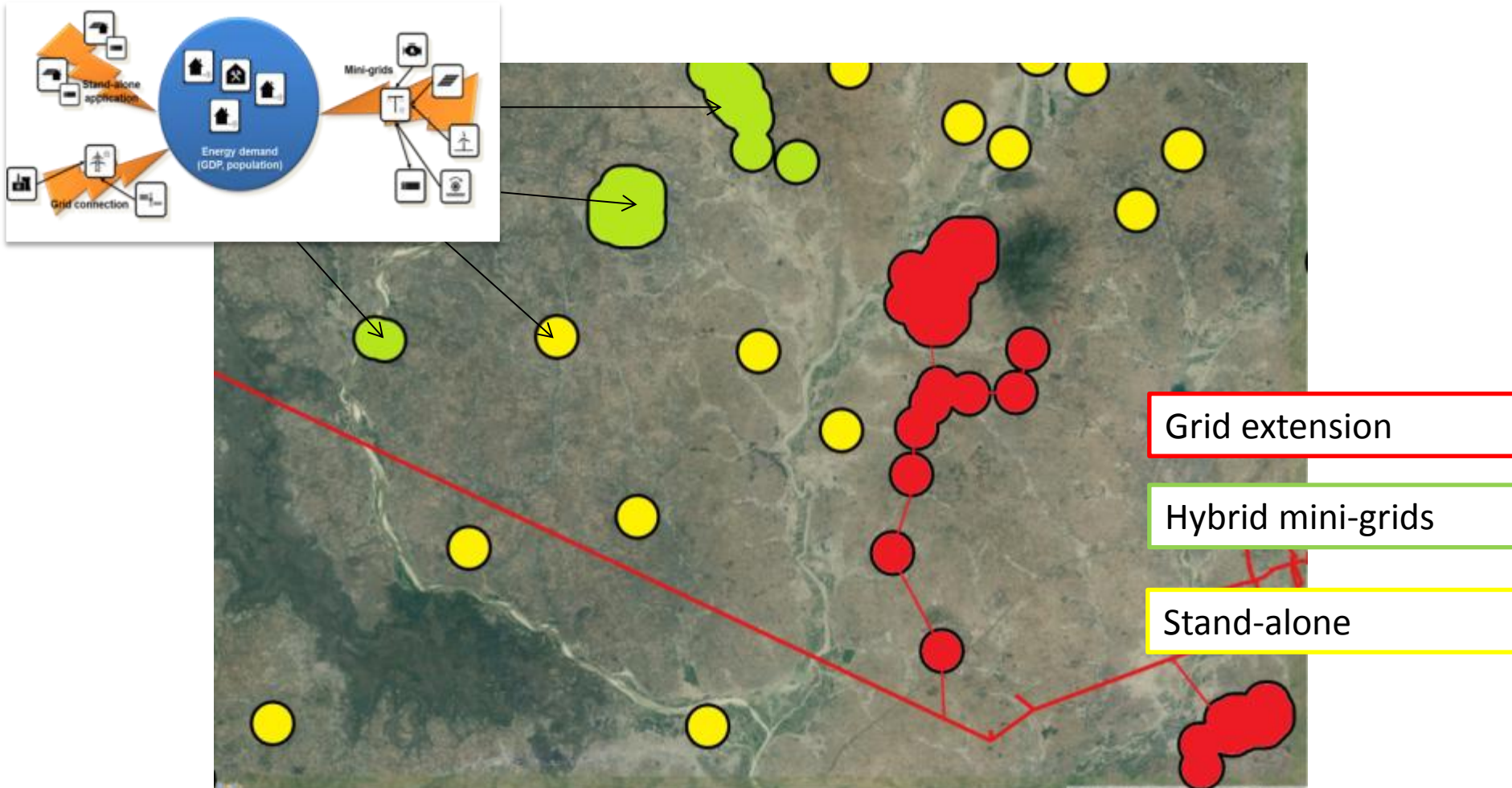
